### Summary:

This event will convene CSW70 participants working on or interested in migration and gender justice to exchange, align, and mobilize around advocacy linked to the upcoming Second International Migration Review Forum (IMRF). Framed around the CSW70 priority theme of access to justice, the session will explore gender justice issues related to migration, situate them within the IMRF process, and provide a shared space for learning, coordination, and collective action. The convening marks the first in a series of dialogues leading up to the Global Gender and Migration Assembly, to be held on the sidelines of the IMRF.

### Target Audience:

- CSW70 participants working on migration-related issues, broadly defined
- Civil society organizations, grassroots groups, advocates, researchers, academics, and other stakeholders engaged in or seeking to strengthen gender-responsive migration policy
- Participants with varying levels of engagement in IMRF-related processes, from those newly exploring the space to those already actively involved

### Objectives:

- Connect migration advocacy to the CSW70 priority theme
- Provide an initial convening space for exchange, alignment, and relationship-building among stakeholders
- Strengthen shared understanding of the IMRF process and its relevance to gender justice and migration
- Identify shared priorities, gaps, and opportunities for collaboration in the lead-up to the IMRF

**Expected Outcomes:**

- Enhanced coordination among actors working at the intersection of gender and migration
- Engagement of participants in a series of online sessions leading up to the Global Gender and Migration Assembly
- Identification of thematic priorities and advocacy messages to inform a collective agenda
- Contributions to a collective outcome document to be presented at the IMRF multi-stakeholder hearing
